Impersonation of police officers

546D <u>Impersonation</u> of police <u>officers</u>

- (1) General offence A <u>person</u> who impersonates a police <u>officer</u> is guilty of an offence.
- : Maximum penalty--Imprisonment for 2 years, or a fine of 100 penalty units, or both.
- (2) Aggravated offence A person who, with intent to deceive--
- (a) impersonates a police officer, and
- (b) purports to exercise a power or function as a police <u>officer</u>, is guilty of an offence.
- : Maximum penalty--Imprisonment for 7 years.
- (3) An offence against subsection (1) is a summary offence.
- (4) In this section--

"impersonation" does not include <u>conduct</u> engaged in solely for satirical purposes.
